


Ryan Korban

Returning for the fifth year, Maker features the work of artisanal North American design stars who produce small batch, limited distributions of their work.

Studio North and Prototype

A marketplace where over 65 Canadian and international designers present custom and limited-edition collections of furniture, lighting, glass ceramics, textiles and surface designs in a gallery-like setting. There is also the chance for participants to have their work judged by a panel of design experts.

Ontario Wood

Ontario Wood is an initiative to help consumers identify and purchase locally made Ontario Wood products. This year's installation by Izen Architecture is a round, open pavilion created from a gradually transforming section. Arrayed in a circular form, an elliptical curve flows through a perfect circle and forms two elongated conical forms with an inner gathering space, not unlike a campfire or encampment in a forest clearing. The inspiration stems from the idea of building forms that are easy to erect, dismantle and relocate, and uses conventional building methods to reimagine a modern sense of gathering and community using standard lumber.


